## MEET THE NEW GUY

On Wednesday the Chicago Wolves announced the addition of 25-year-old Nolan Valleau to the D-corps. The Michigan native arrives to blustery Chicago from sunny Orlando where he skated in 36 ECHL games for the Solar Bears. He paced all Orlando blueliners with eight goals and 22 assists for 30 points, which was also good enough to rank fourth in team scoring overall. Valleau (vah-LOO) began his professional career 76 miles northwest of Allstate Arena in Rockford with the IceHogs. As an undrafted free agent, Valleau signed his first professional contract with the Chicago Blackhawks organization in August 2015 and skated in 108 AHL games for the IceHogs. Valleau gives the Wolves six healthy defensemen as **Petteri Lindbohm** underwent season-ending shoulder surgery on Jan. 6, veteran Jason Garrison was recalled by the Vegas Golden Knights on Jan. 29 for the second time in five days and the St. Louis Blues reassigned rookie Jake Walman to the Binghamton Devils on Jan. 31.

## SHOOTOUT SHUTOUT

This season, the Chicago Wolves have participated in just two shootouts. The last time the Wolves needed game-winning shots to decide a game was Dec. 29 against the Milwaukee Admirals. Milwaukee was the victor as forwards Frederick Gaudreau and Justin Kirkland scored while center Brandon Pirri was the only Wolves skater to solve Anders Lindback. The Wolves are 0-2 in shootouts this season and Pirri (1-2) is the only Wolves player to have scored in either game. Chicago's only other two shooters are Tomas Hyka (0-1) and Teemu Pulkkinen (0-2). The Wolves' first shootout of the season came against their Illinois Lottery Cup rival, the Rockford IceHogs, on Nov. 19. In that contest, Rockford's Vinnie Hinostroza and David Kampf scored for the victory.

# Chicago Wolves Game Notes

BY THE NUMBERS

The Chicago Wolves have been shut out just once this year and that blanking came at the glove of the Milwaukee Admirals' Anders Lindback. On Nov. 8, Lindback stopped all 29 shots he faced while Frederic Allard, U.S. Olympic team member Bobby Butler and Petter Granberg all scored to hand Chicago its largest margin of defeat this season. Conversely, the Wolves have dished out three shutouts this season – all against Central Division rivals. Though five of seven games in the season series have been decided by just one goal, the Admirals have escaped that fate. So far. Chicago netminders Oscar Dansk and Max Lagace are still in search of their first shutouts while Kasimir Kaskisuo owns two of the three Chicago blankings and Michael Leighton owns the third.

If **Kasimir Kaskisuo** starts between the pipes for the Chicago Wolves tonight, it will mark his fifth consecutive start and tie him with **Max Lagace** for most consecutive starts on the season. Kaskisuo already owns the season-high for consecutive appearances with six dating back to Jan. 17 against the lowa Wild when he relieved an injured Lagace at the start of the third period. Through his four consecutive starts, the 24-year-old Kaskisuo owns a 3-0-1 record, a 1.71 goals-against average and a .933 save percentage. Through the first four games of his five-game stint (Dec. 17-27), Lagace produced an identical record (3-0-1), a 2.69 goals-against average and .914 save percentage.

On Jan. 27 against the Tucson Roadrunners, center **Brandon Pirri** took a vicious slash to the hand that resulted in a five-minute power play for the Chicago Wolves. The Wolves took advantage and scored twice on the extra-man opportunity to help propel the club to a 4-3 victory and split the four-game season series with their new Pacific Division foe. That game was the ninth time this season the Wolves have netted multiple power-play goals in a game. Chicago's season-high – three power-play tallies – came on Oct. 14 in the home opener against the Ontario Reign. Additionally, the Wolves opened the season on Oct. 6 with two power-play goals. They have twice netted two goals against the Grand Rapids Griffins (Oct. 27, Dec. 15) and Manitoba Moose (Nov. 17, Jan. 5) and once against the Bakersfield Condors (Jan. 12) and Rockford IceHogs (Dec. 30).

The Chicago Wolves enter tonight's game looking to extend their franchise record home winning streak to 11 consecutive games. The Wolves met the franchise record on Jan. 20 with a 6-1 win over the Bakersfield Condors in the Condors' Allstate Arena debut. The five-goal difference was also Chicago's largest margin of victory this season. The next afternoon, the Wolves pushed the franchise benchmark to 10 games with a 3-1 decision against the Cleveland Monsters. In the 10 contests dating back to Dec. 6 against the San Diego Gulls, the Wolves have outscored opponents 44 to 20 and only once needed overtime to beat an opponent – the then-top ranked Manitoba Moose on Jan. 5. The game featured three-goal efforts from **Brandon Pirri** and Manitoba's Buddy Robinson as well as **Teemu Pulkkinen**'s second overtime goal of the season.
