2017-18 SAN ANTONIO RAMPAGE

GAME PREVIEW: The San Antonio Rampage (8-3-1-0) take on the Chicago Wolves (4-5-1-0) on Saturday, Nov. 11 at 7 p.m. at Allstate Arena. San Antonio heads into the game ranked second in the Western Conference while Chicago is ranked 13th. San Antonio has match the 2003-04 and the 2010-11 campaigns for second best start in franchise history.

A POWER PLAYER: Jordan Schmaltz recorded three power-play assists on Friday Nov. 10 against the Rockford IceHogs, bringing his total to eight power-play points on the season. Schmaltz has the second most power-play assists and third most power-play points in the AHL among defenseman. Schmaltz has appeared in 12 games with the Rampage this season, registering ten points (2g/8a) and eight power-play points (1g/7a).

SPECIAL TEAMS: The Silver and Black tied a franchise record with four power-play goals, all in the first and second period, on Nov. 10 against the IceHogs en route to 6-0 victory. The Rampage improve their November power play to 5-31 (16.1%) after starting the month 1-21 (4.8%). Additionally, the Rampage are ranked sixth in the AHL in penalty kill, stopping 54 of their opponents' 63 power-play opportunities (85.7%) on the season.

THREE-POINT SCORERS: Jordan Schmaltz and Vladislav Kamenev both recorded three assists in Friday's game against the IceHogs to guide the Rampage to a 6-0 victory. San Antonio has had four three-point scorers this season, with Samuel Blais and Andrew Agozzino accomplishing the feat on Oct. 12 against the San Diego Gulls.

NHL SUCCESS: Since being recalled by the Colorado Avalanche, Rocco Grimaldi has recorded one goal and two assists in four games with the Avalanche. Grimaldi appeared in seven games with the Rampage this season, tallying five points (2g/3a). Grimaldi is the seventh player in franchise history to record 100 points and the first since Bobby Butler did it during the 2014-15 campaign.

UP NEXT: The Silver and Black head back to San Antonio to take on the Grand Rapids Griffins on Tuesday, Nov. 14 at 10:30 a.m. at the AT&T Center. The contest will be the second meeting between the two teams.

ROCKFORD, IL (Nov. 10, 2017) - ROCKFORD, IL (Nov. 10, 2017) — San Antonio Rampage goalkeeper Spencer Martin recorded his sixth career shutout as the Rampage (8-3-1-0) defeated the Rockford IceHogs (7-6-0-0) 6-0 at the BMO Harris Bank Center. The Silver and Black recorded four power-play goals, all in the first two periods of the game, to tie a franchise record. David Warsofsky opened the scoring for the Rampage 10:35 into the game with his first goal of the season when his shot from the point kicked off a Rockford skate and landed in the net. Andrew Agozzino made it 2-0 with a two-man advantage power-play goal at 13:51, putting a Jordan Schmaltz rebound past Rockford netminder JF Berube. Chris Butler capped the first period with his first goal of the year, scoring on the power play at 18:57 to make it 3-0 after 20 minutes of action. The Rampage continued their offensive onslaught as Warsofsky netted his second goal of the game after firing a one-time slap shot from the line 9:00 into the second. Mason Geertsen tallied his second goal of the season at 12:33 to make it 5-0 after two frames. Felix Girard added a sixth goal for the Rampage just 38 seconds into the third period to close out the scoring. Martin stopped all 39 shots he faced to complete his sixth career shutout and cap off the 6-0 Rampage victory.

Eric Veilleux (VAY-you) Head Coach

Eric Veilleux (VAY-you) enters his second season as head coach of the San Antonio Rampage... Veilleux, 44, led the Rampage to a record of 27-42-5-2... Before arriving at San Antonio Veilleux spent two seasons with the Norfolk Admirals, first as an assistant in the American Hockey League during the 2014-15 season and then as the head coach when the team moved to the ECHL for the 2015-16 campaign...



A Quebec City native, Veilleux has spent most of his coaching career in the Quebec Major Junior Hockey League (QMJHL), where he accumulated 346 wins in 598 games with the Shawinigan Cataractes (2005-12) and Baie- Comeau Drakkar (2012-14), posting a .579-win percentage...

Veilleux's teams made the playoffs in each of his nine seasons as a head coach in the QMJHL, advancing to the President's Cup Final three times, once with Shawinigan in 2009 and twice with Baie-Comeau in 2013 and 2014... In his final season with Shawinigan in 2012, he led the Cataractes to the franchises first-ever Memorial Cup...

After becoming the head coach of Baie-Comeau the following season, Veilleux coached the Drakkar to two consecutive finals appearances with a 46-20 record and a .697-win percentage in 2013-14, earning the Ron Lapointe Trophy for the QMJHL's Coach of the Year...


